BACKGROUND

HISTORY of COLLECTION

This collection contains a large variety of architectural drawings and renderings that were done by J. Lawson Miller and/or his senior business partner, Samuel C. Falkinburg. The drawings were done in ink and pencil on both linen and vellum paper. Architectural renderings were done in ink and watercolor. Typical projects included architectural designs for residential houses, garages, factory buildings, stores, flats, apartment buildings, and hotels that were located primarily in Detroit or Grosse Pointe. A small number of projects were located in downriver communities and outstate locations. Two outstate locations included a factory design project in Hillsdale, Michigan, and a house design project in Bay City, Michigan. Many of the linen and vellum drawings also have accompanying blueprints and typewritten specifications.

John Lawson Miller was born in Lake Orion, Oakland County, Michigan, on March 27, 1878, and was the son of Seymon B. and Hannah L. (Woodley) Miller. His father was a miller by trade. His grandfather, Nicholas B. Miller, was a blacksmith and was one of the early pioneers of the Lake Orion area. After high school, J. Lawson Miller moved to Detroit and spent several years working for various architects and firms including Baxter & Hill, S. (Samuel) C. Falkinburg, Joseph E. Mills, and Rogers & McFarlane. He eventually became the head draftsman at the office of S. C. Falkinburg and later became a partner in the firm in 1904. After Falkinburg's death in 1905, J. Lawson Miller carried on the architecture business mostly on his own. The title blocks on several project plan sheets in the collection do list the name of an associate architect, but the bulk of the projects list only J. Lawson Miller as the project architect. Detroit City directory listings indicated that his downtown office was located in the Goebel Building in Cadillac Square. His long-time home in Detroit was located at 55 Rosedale Court between Woodward and John R. In 1904, J. Lawson Miller married Miss Nellie Gooney in New York City. Miss Gooney,

daughter of Michael Gooney, was born in Ireland and she immigrated to Detroit in about 1893. It is not known if they had any children.

Some of Lawson's early projects (pre-1910) have no job numbers or dates so it is difficult to set a precise year on these drawings. It appears that he carried on the project numbering sequence of his predecessor, S. C. Falkinburg, but most of Falkinburg's work must have been discarded or lost since there are no job numbers listed prior to 128. Detroit City directories did not list S. C. Falkinburg until 1894 and he was shown as residing in Ypsilanti for both 1894 and 1895. Possibly, he may have done his early architectural work in the Ypsilanti area before moving to Detroit in 1896. The earliest job number in the collection (Job 128), was a house for Dr. George Andrews in Highland Park, dated c.1895. The last job number (Job 312), was a factory building addition for the C.M Hall Lamp Company, dated 1937.

J. Lawson Miller was a member of several fraternal organizations and was also a charter member of the Michigan Society of Architects. He died in 1969 and was buried in Evergreen Cemetery, Lake Orion, Michigan.

TIMELINE of COLLECTION

- 1895 Earliest drawings in the collection date approximately from this year.
- 1901 First Detroit City directory entry where J. Lawson Miller, draftsman, was listed as being employed by S. C. Falkinburg.
- 1904 J. Lawson Miller became a partner in the firm of S. C. Falkinburg, on October 24.
- 1905 Senior partner, S. C. Falkinburg, died on July 3, 1905, at age 64.
- 1937 The last design project in the collection, Job 312, is completed. (See object numbers 1981.021.070 and 1981.021.138.)

Directory Notes:

- 1. Directory listings for 1896 and 1898 show a "John L. Miller" as a watchman and a fireman, respectively. It is not known if this John L. Miller was the same John L. Miller who was listed as a draughtsman in the 1897 directory.
- Address numbers of most houses and businesses changed as of January 1, 1921, due to a citywide address re-numbering program. For example, "27 Rosedale Ct." became "55 Rosedale Ct."
- 3. The directories began including spouse's names in parentheses in 1927-28.
- 4. Some directory listings for J. Lawson Miller's business address are inconsistent from year to year. However, "315 Goebel Building," "315 Detroit Mortgage Building," and "138 Cadillac Square, R315 [Room 315]" all appear to be the same location.
- 5. By 1934, J. Lawson Miller had closed his downtown office and was working from his home to complete his remaining architectural projects.
- 6. No city directories were published from 1942 through 1952 and they were published sporadically from 1953 through 1974.
