Accessibility is a central tenet of the Detroit Historical Society's core values. As it works to ensure that the Dossin Great Lakes Museum's exhibitions and programming are accessible to the broadest range of constituents possible, including individuals with disabilities, the Society has become a Certified Autism Center to better serve its neuro-diverse visitors. The Society has refined exhibition spaces and posted sensory guides to alert visitors to the level of stimulation present in each gallery. Sensory bags are available at the registration desk and family events regularly offer special hours for individuals who would benefit from a less stimulating museum experience.








### **Dossin Great Lakes Museum Map**





- Low impact on this sense








Sensory Levels (1= Low Sensory Stimulation, 10= High Sensory Stimulation)








- · Visitors can climb into two different boats for photo opportunities


 Opportunity for tactile engagement with parts of the exhibit
